



## 2020 Triennial Elections & Special Resolution Vote

### DECLARATION OF RESULTS

I declare the results for the election of Trustees and special resolution vote undertaken on behalf of Te Korowai o Ngāruahine Trust by postal, internet and ballot box at the annual general meeting that closed on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2020. I confirm that the official result was determined after the scrutiny of the electoral roll was completed, the validity of all votes was determined, and all valid votes were counted.

**Ngawai HERNANDEZ-WALDEN** and **John Henry Te Urikore Katene HOOKER** are declared elected as trustees for the Ōkahu-Inuawai hapū electorate.

The voter return for this hapū electorate was 25.70% being 184 votes cast from 716 eligible electors, of which 66.85% voted on the internet and 33.15% voted by post or at the wāhi pōti.

**Te Aroha HOHAIA** and **Te Ahu (Randal) REI** are declared elected as trustees for the Ngāti Tū hapū electorate.

The voter return for this hapū electorate was 35.77% being 230 votes cast from 643 eligible electors, of which 68.70% voted on the internet and 31.30% voted by post or at the wāhi pōti.

**Kiri ERB** and **Ferinica HAWE-FOREMAN** are declared elected as trustees for the Ngāti Manuhiakai **hapū** electorate.

The voter return for this hapū electorate was 30.53% being 178 votes cast from 583 eligible electors, of which 65.73% voted on the internet and 34.27% voted by post or at the wāhi pōti.

**Caroline SCOTT** and **Grant WESTON** are declared elected as trustees for the Ngāti Tamaahuroa me Titahi **hapū** electorate.

The voter return for this hapū electorate was 28.86% being 129 votes cast from 447 eligible electors, of which 76.74% voted on the internet and 23.26% voted by post or at the wāhi pōti.

*To Amend the Te Korowai o Ngāruahine Trust Deed as set out in the Proposal to amend the Te Korowai Trust Deed (June 2020).*

Section 19 of Te Korowai o Ngāruahine Trust Deed requires resolutions for change to the trust deed to be approved by not less than 75% of the adult members who are entitled to vote and cast a valid vote on the resolution. As less than 75% of registered adult members who cast a valid vote on the special resolution voted APPROVED, I declare the special resolution to be **LOST**.

The voter return on the special resolution vote was 26.78%, being 973 votes cast from 3,633 eligible electors, of which 69.58% voted on the internet and 30.42% voted by post or at the wāhi pōti.
