DECLARATION OF RESULT

Te Korowai O Ngāruahine Trust Resolution 2

Votes Received

I agree that the definition of Ngāruahine in the Te Korowai o Ngāruahine Trust Deed be amended to the following: 'Ngāruahine' means:

- a *the collective group composed of individuals who descend from one or more Ngāruahine Ancestors, and affiliate to one or more of the following hapū:*
 - i *Kanihi-Umutahi (me etehi);*
 - ii *Ngāti Haua;*
 - iii *Ngāti Manuhiakai;*
 - iv *Ngāti Tamaahuroa-Titahi,*
 - v *Ngāti Tu;*
 - vi *Okahu-Inuawai (me etehi atu);*
- b. *every individual referred to in paragraph (a) above.*

For the purposes of this definition, a descendant may be descended by:

- a. *birth; or*
- b. *legal adoption;*

but does not include any individual who is a whāngai and who does not descend from a Ngāruahine ancestor.

The majority (being 88.08%) of valid votes cast on the resolution voted **YES/ĀE**.

I therefore declare that Te Korowai O Ngāruahine Trust Resolution 2 is Accepted.

The voter return was 37.25%, being 995 votes cast from 2,671 eligible electors, of which 54.97% voted on the internet and 45.03% voted by post or at the AGM.
